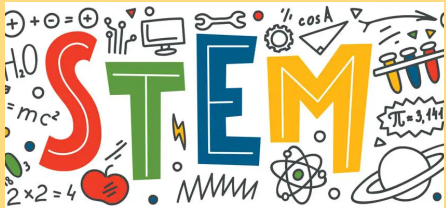
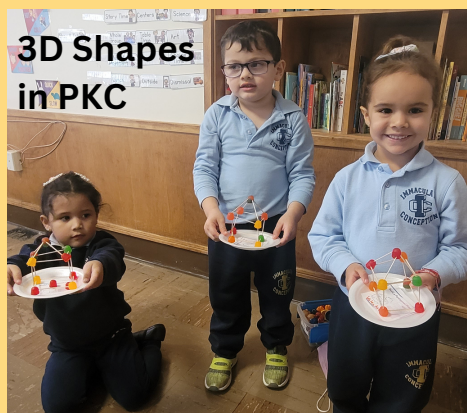

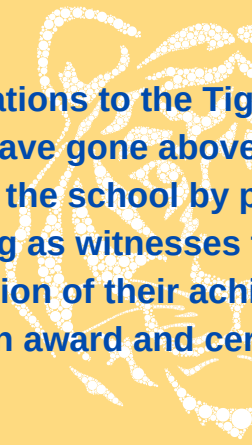
Important Dates

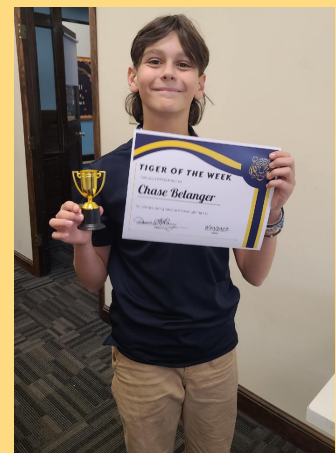

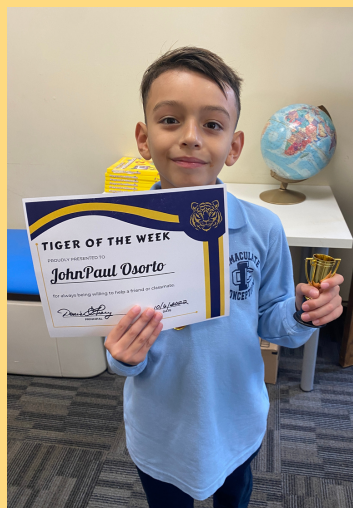
